**The 2019 West Coast Challenge will be played over four of the finest links Courses along the Wild Atlantic Way - Bundoran, Donegal, Enniscrone and Strandhill.**

Each course will provide a superb test of a golfers skills and each is magnificently situated against the rolling seascapes and mountain backed hinterland of Donegal and Sligo.

The event is confined to amateur golfers with a handicap limit of 22 for men and 30 for ladies. The competition is a 3 person team event (any combination). The entry fee is €155 per person. Play will be in 3 balls. Each competitor will play 18 holes over the four Courses on successive days.

Entries will only be accepted from golfers who are members of affiliated clubs and must have an official club handicap. Scoring will be on the stableford system. Players must produce their current exact handicap on the 1st day of the Tournament, or provide GUI/ILGU number.



**BUNDORAN GOLF CLUB**

Bundoran Golf Club, founded in 1894, one of the oldest golf clubs in Ireland, is a cliff top links on a rugged headland jutting out into Donegal Bay on the Wild Atlantic Way. Set against the background of the magnificent Dartry Mountains our golfer friendly Course, situated in the town, has panoramic views of the Atlantic Ocean and should the wind blow it will present a challenge to all golfers.



**DONEGAL GOLF CLUB**

The Championship Links Course at Donegal Golf Club, on the breath-taking Murvagh peninsula, offers golfers of all abilities an enjoyable experience. The course is set over dunes formed by the might of the Atlantic Ocean & allows players to take in the spectacular panoramic views of Donegal Bay & the Bluestack Mountains. 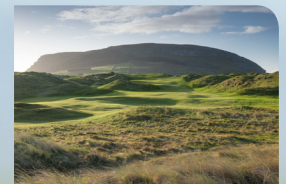
**ENNISCRONE GOLF CLUB**

Enniscrone Golf Club has some of the largest most formidable sand dunes on the island of Ireland. **STRANDHILL GOLF CLUB**

Strandhill is an exciting links course where golfers are guaranteed not only a wonderful golfing experience but also truly spectacular views of the coastline. The course is surrounded by spectacular landscapes steeped in history and mythology and which have been immortalised in the writings of WB Yeats. The Atlantic breezes, towering sand dunes and the spectacular backdrops of mystical Knocknarea and the wild Atlantic crashing onto the shores makes playing golf at Strandhill an experience not to be missed.



The competition will take place from Monday 2nd - Thursday 5th September 2019, with the prize giving taking place on Thursday 5th at 9.30 pm. The competition will be run under GUI / ILGU rules.
